## **ACTION & IMPACT**

75 social justice documentaries and websites produced by youth on critical issues of our day, including lead poisoning of school water, eating disorders, social media beauty standards, abortion access for immigrants, media coverage of war, income inequality, and the impact of war on education.

15,140 worldwide audiences reached by youth and their films.

7 official selections in 5 film festivals nationwide.

Narrative Change and Community Action: WE ACT for Environmental Justice hosted a community event and screening of 24 EVC youth produced films at Washington Height's Expeditionary Learning Schools, a NYC public K-12. The theme was environmental justice, and topics included housing, garbage, and substance abuse. The event was part of an ongoing community conversation about creating a green corridor in Washington Heights.



EVC partners with public schools and community organizations that work with young people enduring the trauma of longstanding systemic oppression.

Across all programs, 39 public school communities were empowered to create transformative, student-centered learning environments by providing 25 teachers and their students with 2,230 hours of programming.

100% of partner schools renewed relationship with EVC for another year of programming.

and use original youth-produced media to disrupt systems and narratives harming BIPOC youth and their communities













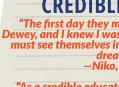


## YOUTH SPOTLIGHT CHRISTAIN, EVC ALUM

"EVC opened something inside of me I didn't know I had. It gave me skills and a chance to tell my story. Now all I want is to help people, to be the role model I didn't have growing up. EVC has become my family."

Born and raised in Harlem, Christain joined EVC in 2021 as a high school junior at Lower East Side Prep. High School. EVC immediately helped him feel safe and supported—and, eventually, brave enough to pitch the idea of making a documentary about an issue close to his heart: anti-BIPOC racism in the LGBTQIA+ community. Since that semester, Christain keeps returning to EVC. He has participated in three Youth Doc Workshop cohorts and helped train EVC's educators. He successfully pitched the topics for all three films, including "Gatekeeping the Bills," that reflects another reality he grew up in: economic inequality and racism. EVC has helped Christain see how his experience is a bigger story of structural inequities harming his communities, and it's helped him tell that story in a way that empowers both him and his community.

### TRANSFORMING NYC'S COMMUNITY OF EDUCATORS CREDIBLE EDUCATORS

"As a credible educator and an LGBTQ immigrant, I am helping immigrant and queer youth feel safe and connected. And they are teaching me as much as I am teaching them." —David, Credible Educators



Research shows that BIPOC students perform markedly better in school and life when they benefit from having teachers with shared experiences and racial identities. Yet our nation's community of educators suffers from a longstanding lack of diversity. Designed in response to EVC youth suggestions, Credible Educators aims to address this need. Piloted in 2022, Credible Educators recruits, trains, places in jobs, and mentors educators of color in order to create transformative learning environments for BIPOC students. And in response to the current surge of immigrant youth into New York City schools, Credible Educators is focusing, in part, on training educators like David and Niko who can meet these young people where they are and walk with them through a very vulnerable moment in their lives.

### TRANSFORMING SCHOOLS **LOWER EAST SIDE** PREP. HIGH SCHOOL

"EVC provides our students with support for mental health, educational growth, and building community. They make our students feel heard, cared for, and like they are part of a special community."





EVC has partnered with Lower East Side Preparatory High School (LESP) since 2018, serving 25 students. The partnership highlights how EVC's approach not only builds educational, creative, pre-professional, and social emotional capacities of students, but also shifts the culture within an entire school, one student, one educator at a time. EVC's holistic approach supports youth, and it also models youth-centered care and pedagogies for the students' village of adults at their school. LESP students, many of them newcomers to the United States, have joined EVC programs while struggling with multiple challenges. EVC gives them educational, language, and social emotional skills, and, above all, a sense of community.
